\$125 and the general public pays \$175.

Policies and Restrictions

The Center is a non-smoking facility.

Renters may use the park at no additional
charge, but the park is open to the public.

Neighborhood noise ordinances prohibit the
use of disc jockeys, bands, amplified music
or other live music without express permis-
sion of the Board in advance.

No beer kegs.

Parties must remain inside the building, and
avoid congregating outside entrance doors
or along streets or sidewalks.

No vehicles are permitted on park grounds.
